

- 8. Reservations for all parties, services, experiences and trips must be mutually arranged with the donor for mutually agreeable dates and times unless otherwise specified. These cannot be exchanged for cash or used against an existing balance.
- 9. **CAUTION:** All items that had to be assembled, such as bicycles, gas grills, etc. should be thoroughly inspected and tightened before using. We do not want anyone to get hurt because something may have been overlooked during assembly.
