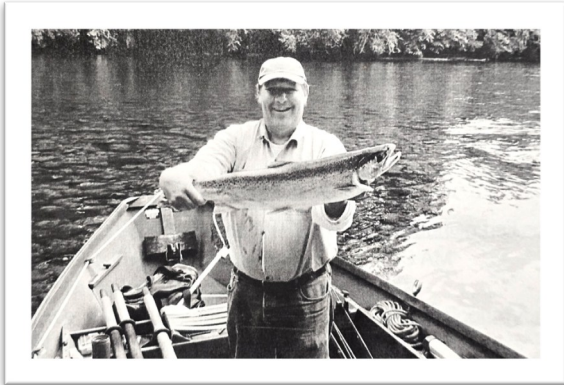
# In Memory of Steve Bauder

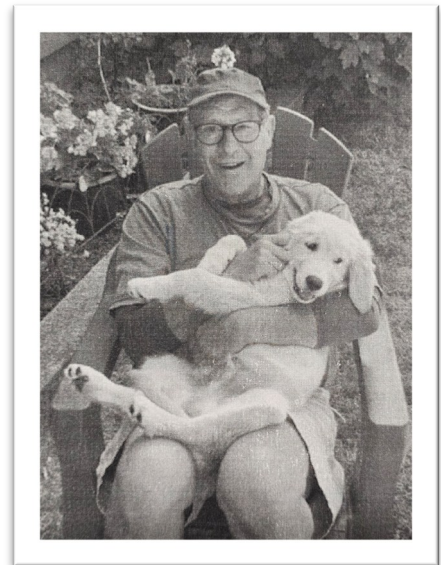

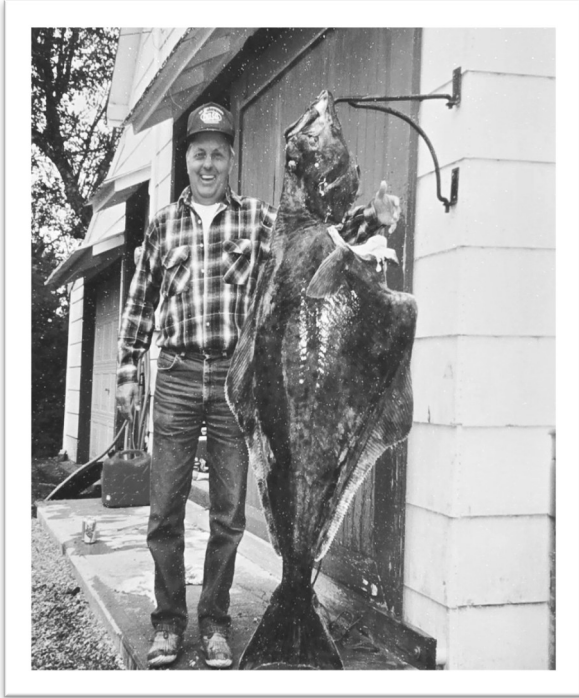


The BASA banquet was one of Steve's most anticipated events each year. It wasn't just about the
